



**STANDARDISED PRICE LIST**

All funeral directors are legally required to publish the price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors as prices can vary. A full listing of funeral options is on the main business website under Funeral costings. If you scroll down the page you will also find our Gold, Silver and Bronze packages with costing for each and what is included.

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL: (Funeral director's total charges for silver package - hearse only)</b>	<b>£2,600.00</b>
<i>This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation at one single place, burial chapel or crematorium.</i>	
<b>What is included in the above cost:</b>	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements and paperwork	<b>£600.00</b>
Collecting and transporting the deceased from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral directors care (normal working hours)	<b>£120.00</b>
Care of the deceased before the funeral in appropriate facilities, the deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises	<b>£950.00</b>
Dressing of the deceased in own clothes, viewing in the chapel of rest for family and friends (where viewing is requested by the customer at a date and time you agree with the funeral director)	<b>£0.00</b>
At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (Normally within 15 miles of the funeral directors premises) in a hearse with all staff to carry out the funeral	<b>£530.00</b>
Providing a suitable coffin (simulated veneer coffin)	<b>£400.00</b>
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
<i>This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</i>	
<b>Burial</b> (Funeral director's charges only) Burial and grave fees to be added to this cost <b>(1)</b>	<b>£1,200.00 plus coffin</b>
<b>Cremation</b> (Funeral director's charges excluding cremation fee / doctors fee <b>(2)</b> )	<b>£975.00 plus coffin</b>
<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY: Also known as third party fees</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>Burial fee (1)</b> is the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents for a new grave. (Lewisham Borough – First interment included, lawn grave 50 year lease)	<b>£4,442.00</b>
For an existing grave with or without a memorial in place, you will need to pay a removal/replacement fee, in addition the cemetery may charge a number of other fees to re-open the grave	<b>price on request</b>
For an attended cremation funeral, the <b>Cremation fee (2)</b> the typical cost for ( <b>Lewisham Crematorium</b> )	<b>£914.00</b>
<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
<i>The funeral director can supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples as follows;</i>	
Additional mileage (price per mile)	<b>TBA</b>
Transfer the deceased (to their home or to a place of worship the night before a funeral service)	<b>£160.00</b>
Delivery of ashes back to family up 5 miles from Funeral directors	<b>£50.00</b>
Funeral officiant (Celebrant, minister of religion)	<b>Price on request</b>

- (1) This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.  
 (2) In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
